### Footnotes

STAGE MOTHER set the pace from the start, saved ground on the turn and led throughout while finishing under steady encouragement. SUPER SILVER was close up early, raced three wide on the turn, then rallied late and was second best. SUPER QUEEN was slow early, saved ground on the turn, then closed ground willingly. CLASSY SENORITA raced along the four path on the turn and lacked a rally. HAPPY SPIRIT pressed the pace early, raced two wide on the turn, then weakened in the stretch. AHEADOFTHEBEST was close up early, raced inside on the turn, then flattened out in the stretch.
