D' WILD AFFAIR vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, entered into a long drive then drew clear late while under urging. GRILLER vied for the lead from the three path through the turn, the dueled in the stretch and gave way. TIME FOR A WINNER vied for the lead from along the inside through the turn, then weakened in the stretch. CASANOVA JACK broke in the air, then was slow early and raced three wide on the turn but found his best stride late. KIERNAN'S LEGACY was never far back, raced two wide through the turn and lacked a rally. GLOBAL EFFECT raced along the inside on the turn and was not a threat. DIRT DIVER was close up early, saved ground on the turn then angled outward entering the stretch and faded. REXDALE WARRIOR saved ground on the turn while trailing the field.
