ROYAL IGNITION was never far back, raced along the inside throughout, then drew off late and was ridden out to the wire. BUCKLE UP BEN vied for the lead from the start, raced along the two path through the last turn, then was no match for the winner. STRIKING HAT was unhurried early, raced along the inside through the second turn, then made a late bid. OUTLAW CHOCTAW was close up early, raced two wide on the second turn, then weakened in the stretch. TELL HIM ON was close up and three wide through the last turn, then failed to sustain that bid. IZZY'S LITTLE FOOT pressed the pace from the start, raced three wide and contended on the last turn, then faded late. NO ORDINARY GUY raced two wide on the last turn and failed to menace. ESTRELLA'S SON vied for the lead from the two path, then faltered on the second turn and was outrun.
