LITTLE NIKKI was never far back, raced along the inside on the last turn, raced evenly throughout and finished second best. SILVER PARTNER was slow early, raced inside on the last turn while advancing steadily then rallied mildly. JERI'S REPORT was slow early, raced three wide on the last turn, then made a mild bid in the stretch. LADY GDANSKI was void of early speed raced three wide on the second turn and was not a threat. SHINE OLA pressed the pace early, raced three wide on the far turn then faded. MS MIA vied for the early lead, raced two wide on the last turn then flattened out. SILVER MOMENT was through early, raced three wide on the far turn and was outrun.
