Footnotes

ECLIPTICALS T BIRD stalked the pace from along the inside, reached contention on the second turn then drew off late while under urging. PILOT LIGHT pressed the pace from the two wide through the last turn, then made a late bid to be second best. MR. FIUME raced to contention early, was three wide through the far turn, then gave way in the stretch. BRAVE SAMSON was slow early, raced three wide on the second turn, then made a mild bid in the stretch. DETERMINED DREAM was unhurried early, raced two wide on the last turn and failed to menace. RUN DIXIE vied for the early lead, raced two wide on the far turn, then faded in the stretch. BALLE ENCORE was close up early, raced along the inside on the last turn, then lacked a late response. ERLAND BALLROOM lacked speed, saved ground on the second turn and was outrun. ETAR vied for the lead on the backstretch, then faltered entering the last turn and was eased in the stretch.
