STOLEN DANCE stalked the pace from the start, raced two wide through the second turn, then rallied late and drew off under urging. FLYNNIE set the pace early, raced along the inside and was pressured throughout, then gave way late. DOPKE GAL was unhurried early, raced along the inside on the far turn, then closed ground willingly. SISTER SHARON was never far back, raced three wide on the second turn, then made a late bid and weakened. WHAT A DELIGHT was slow early, saved ground on the last turn, then made a mild bid late. FIGHT CAT was void of early speed and wide, then angled in on the far turn and rallied mildly. NEW FREEDOM stalked the pace from the four path through the last turn then faded in the stretch. PERIWINKLE raced two wide on the second turn and failed to menace. GRABTHESILVERNGO was close up early, saved ground on the last turn, then faltered late. SOUTH BEACH HOTTIE lacked speed, raced four wide on the far turn and was outrun.
