TWILLERBEE stalked the pace from along the inside, reached contention on the second turn then drew off in the stretch and just lasted at the wire while under urging. MORE THAN CRAFTY was never far back, raced along the inside on the last turn then angled to the outside and rallied late just missing at the wire. PORTENA set the pace with a clear lead, raced two wide and was headed on the far turn, then gave way in the drive. SPEAK LIB was unhurried early, raced two wide on the second turn, then rallied mildly in the stretch. SENECA LAKE pressed the pace from the start, raced two wide on the last turn, then faded late. MAGNIFICENT IMAGE was close up early, raced four wide on the far turn then lacked a rally late. SLIPSTITCH lacked speed, raced four wide on the second turn and showed little throughout. A BIT LIT prompted the early pace, raced three wide on the second turn and was outrun.
