PENT UP stalked the pace from the two path through the turn, then rallied late and drew off under urging. THE GALLOPING GHOST pressed the pace from along the inside through the turn, then made a late bid to be second best. THE A. TRAIN vied for the early lead from the two path, drew clear on the turn then was headed late and gave way. OUT OF PRINT vied for the lead from along the inside through the turn, then weakened late. FOUR N THREE was never far back, raced three wide on the turn then rallied mildly in the lane. NO PASSAGE was unhurried early, raced along the inside on the turn, then found his best stride late. BRASS KNUCKLES was close up early, raced four wide on the turn then faded in the stretch. CONFLICTED raced two wide on the turn and failed to menace. STALLONE pressed the early pace, raced three wide on the turn, then faltered in mid stretch. REWARD ME NOW was through early, raced four wide on the turn and was outrun.
