REPRISE was unhurried inside, came out four wide while moving early on the far turn, was carried very wide nearing the stretch, moved clear in early stretch and was kept to urging. MUD DUCK lagged early, circled into the stretch and finished willingly outside. EBOY was unhurried, raced two wide into the stretch, bore out into MIGHTY ORATOR entering the final furlong then continued evenly. PREACHER'S KID bore out in good position on the first turn, moved to vie three wide on the final turn then bore out again and flattened out. MIGHTY ORATOR pressed the pace from between rivals, vied on the final turn, was bumped and carried out in early stretch and tired. CORPORATE COPY was carried wide while close up on the first turn then stopped. SPEEDY ARMORY stayed out from the rail while making the way into the far turn then stopped.
