POLO BEAR was never far back, raced inside on the turn, then rallied late and was up for place. SUPERTEN pressed the pace early, contended on the turn then gained a late lead and drifted in while tiring in the stretch. ROLL DEM BONES was close up and three wide on the turn, then made a late bid but drifted outward and checked late. KING RAFFIE was unhurried early, raced along the inside on the turn then rallied mildly. MANNED UP pressed the pace from the start, raced inside through the turn, then weakened late. WILD ROVER vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, then faded in the stretch. ZICO was slow early, raced three wide on the turn and was not a threat. SGT. SLADE vied for the early lead, raced two wide on the turn, then fired from those efforts. THUNDER LIKELY vied for the lead from the inside through the turn, then flattened out in the drive. DIAVOLO ROSSO lacked speed, was through early and showed little. MOONLIT CHARMER showed good early speed, raced two wide on the turn, then faltered and was outrun.
