TRULY DIVINE made a run leaving the far turn and finished willingly to close the gap. RIGHT NICE PHILLY was well placed close to the pace and lacked the needed closing response. OMO moved closer on the far turn and finished well to just miss for third. SINGLE SCOOP moved up along the inside on the far turn then lacked the needed closing response. WINDY ANGEL prompted the early pace then weakened. BEST ACTRESS showed little. MARCO'S RED ROSE tired from her early effort. TOUGH HOLIDAY tired. COUNTRY PRIZE was through early.
