WEEKEND GAMES vied for the lead from the outset and held off the challenge of ARRRR in the final furlong. ARRRR moved up between rivals leaving the turn, loomed boldly in the final furlong but was not good enough. DR. DALE moved up along the inside around the turn and up late for third. BUSHY'S YIELD moved up wide leaving the turn then lacked the needed response. ALTERED vied for the lead racing near the inside rail then weakened in the drive. DIAMOND ROCK prompted the early pace and tired. TRIPPI DANCE was outrun. SPENCER'S GIFT hopped at the start then was outrun. DISENGAGEMENT, outrun, was eased through the stretch.
