MIDATLANTIC worked his way between rivals leaving the backstretch and into the far turn then lodged a five wide bid to gain the lead at the top of the stretch and won under steady pressure. BRANDONS BEACH stalked the pace, was checked in traffic leaving the far turn then closed well. OMAHA BEACH edged closer along the inside around the far turn and got up late for third. TIZ IS, well placed racing close up outside rivals, lacked the needed response. ALVAN WAS GREAT stalked the leader through the far turn then weakened in the drive. BLAMEITONMYOUTH stumbled at the start. MAY EIGHTEENTH broke alertly to show the way for six furlongs then weakened. KINGS CONCERTO lacked a rally. AMACHE tired.
