KING OF AMERICA moved closer into the far turn then was under a long drive to run down the leader. BOOK shook clear on the backstretch then drifted out in the final furlong and was caught late. CINDERMAN rallied mildly outside rivals in the stretch. GOLDEN MUSTANG was well placed close up and lacked the needed closing response. OFFICER RON moved closer around the far turn then needed more in the drive. T. J. HIGHWAY lacked a rally. RAPID ENCOUNTER was fractious loading then showed little. MOUNT BREVETOR was outrun. FREE FRANKIE tired from his early effort. WESTERN MYSTERY stopped completing a half mile then was eased in the final furlong.
