DOMESTIC BREW raced in close pursuit, moved up menacingly outside the winner a quarter mile out then was not good enough. SOVEREIGN FUND raced within striking distance but lacked a solid rally. CREDIT SQUEEZE was forwardly placed then flattened out in the drive. HAWSER showed little.
