FOR YOUR LOVE bobbed slightly at the start then moved up outside rivals into the stretch and was under strong handling to run down the leader. AVARY TOO STEP moved up menacingly three wide on the turn then fought it out gamely to the end. SNAPPY TUNE closed outside rivals to get up in time for the show. WYATT'S HIGH NOON raced within striking distance but lacked the needed stretch response. FIELDS OF GAIL was outrun to the stretch then rallied mildly between rivals. STRAWBERRY SKY prompted the pace and weakened in the drive. BRAG BAG broke alertly to show the way for a half mile then weakened. ONE BAD SISTER raced close up along the inside under a rating hold then had nothing for the drive. INDIAN ISLAND showed little.
