ELMER'S GIRL saved ground, took the lead leaving furlong grounds and edged clear. MY DIZZY GIRL saved ground early, eased out near the stretch but then had no late gain. STARLIT LILLY raced out from the rail and took the lead near stretch, weakened. JORDANA JORDANA was well placed between foes, came up empty. MARIBELS GRAYGIRL raced well out from the rail but between foes, failed to menace. PRIMULA raced wide. MISS SASSY STORM was very wide on the turn and into stretch. SMOKEY ROSE broke poorly and lost best chance. WHYWHY ME set the pace just off the rail and stopped. SCREEN STAR broke down on the turn.
