RISINGALMA raced wide, regained the lead in mid stretch and won under strong handling. ECONOMIC IMPACT raced two wide, took the lead before a half and then edged clear and then gave way grudgingly. CRYSTAL SPIRIT was unhurried early, rallied between foes into stretch and finished well. RINGSIDE ALICIA saved ground and was too late. HOLD FAST was inside under a snug hold, eased out near the stretch and hung. FOWL SUPPER, two wide and just off early pace, tired.
