A LOT OF MARY joined for command three wide on the turn, took the lead in mid stretch and edged clear. TIMELY AFFAIR dueled between foes, took the lead on the turn and gave way grudgingly. ELFIN GLEN was outrun early, raced wide on turn and into stretch but was too late. MOLLY'S MINT steadied when blocked between foes on the far turn. LIME LAKE was outrun early and then raced very wide turn and into stretch but was too late. WINGED DELITE dueled two wide, was left with the rail on the turn, tired. MISS CHEERS, well placed between foes, tired. ANOTHER BETTY saved ground, was also steadied along lacking room on the far turn. ZENNA THE RULER dueled just off rail and then had nothing left. MAXNIECE failed to menace.
