HEFFERMAN reserved early, rallied between rivals on the final turn then drew off quickly while under wraps late. BOLDLY SUCCESSFUL saved ground to the final turn, advanced very wide into the stretch but was no match for the winner. PIPER'S FORT dropped back early saving ground, made a brief bid after half a mile then flattened out. INDIAN WAR DANCE set a clear pace then widened his margin on the final turn before faltering. LEGACY RESERVE moved within striking range early, dropped back and lacked a rally. BLUEFINGER raced between rivals and then inside and never menaced. OCEANOGRAPHY prompted the pace three wide for half a mile then gave way. GOLDEN GATOR was always outrun. MORAL FIBER forced the pace for half a mile then stopped abruptly.
