DREAMADREAMFORME matched strides two abreast with TRENDY NATIVE and pulled away in the final furlong under strong handling. SAM'S SIXTEENTH was outrun to the stretch then finished with good energy to get up in time for second. TRENDY NATIVE broke alertly to dispute pace racing off the rail then faded in the drive and was nosed out for second. BLIND CANYON, never far back, rallied mildly. REGAL AND COOL, forwardly placed, lacked a solid rally. ROYAL MARGE failed to be a threat. SAUCEYRUBIN raced close up along the inside to the stretch then faded. CHEPPER tired. NICKNAME showed little. DEL MAR DREAMIN' broke alertly to prompt the pace and had nothing left for the drive.
