WOODACRE made a run along the inside rail into the stretch then closed gamely to collar the pacesetter and drew clear in the final 70 yards. PLOSH didn't break alertly then responded gamely between horses to get up for second. HARDKNOCKINBILLIE lost ground around the turn then finished gamely to just miss for second. NINE MILLIMETER broke sharp to set the pace to deep stretch then faded. MON OF THUNDER broke a step slowly then failed to be a threat. FOR IVYMOUNT broke slowly then was outrun. SMARTY'S GOLD had no visible mishap. MOUNTAIN CLIMBER broke alertly to be a forward factor then weakened in the drive. CHANNINGSTOWN prompted the early pace then tired. INDY KNIGHT was outrun. SHORT SHRIFT showed little.
