SPECIAL VIRTUE moved closer along the inside on the far turn, eased out in midstretch then closed to run down the leader late. SCARLET GILIA bobbled at the start then stalked the pace four wide, ran down the leader in the final furlong under strong handling then was caught late. MINT REPORT saved ground setting the pace into the final furlong and was not good enough. LAUREN'S TOUR made a run around rivals on the far turn then lacked the needed closing bid. ONE TWIST moved up along the inside into the far turn then lacked the needed closing response. VIRTUELESS WOMAN raced with the pace two abreast and weakened in the drive. SKIP TRIAL MISS prompted the pace three wide and tired. FAST LANE TERRY was pulled up before a half mile.
