WINESTONE raced between foes, was carried out entering the lane and then gave way. MINOR ISSUES raced wide. PROUD ALE bobbled leaving gate, saved ground, drifted out entering the stretch and dropped back. BELGIAN CHOCOLATE failed to menace. JUICY LUCY raced three wide, was fanned very wide into stretch.
