GOLD EXCHANGE failed to seriously menace. CORPORATE LADY rallied belatedly along the inside. INTIMATE MUSIC saved ground and flattened out in the drive. SILVER SILENCE vied for the early lead and tired. HILLSIDE EXPRESS showed nothing. GREAT AUNT ALICE was outrun. SEA DRAGONESS stopped leaving the backstretch.
