LOST THE SIGNAL raced between foes early but then was left with the rail, eased out in the stretch, took the lead and won going away. GLOUCESTER STAGE set the pace inside, held a clear lead in mid stretch, couldn't last. HONEY GAL eased off the rail and lacked a strong finish. HOLLY HEDGE raced wide, rallied too late. MISTACALL failed to menace. TEJANO SYMPHONY showed little. AMERICAN BABY raced two wide and just off pace, tired. BY FAR A LADY raced wide, challenged on the turn but then gave way. AGAINST MY WILL was outside and just off the early pace, tired. SAY A FEW SYLLABLES failed to menace. SHANNON MAID stopped badly. SHAKEITLIKESHAKIRA RAN OFF PRIOR TO THE START AND WAS ORDERED SCRATCHED BY THE STEWARDS. THAT INCIDENT PLUS A LONG GATE LOAD CAUSED A 6 MINUTE DELAY IN POST TIME.
