FADE SABIHONDA (ARG) advanced between rivals through the backstretch, moved to the lead with a two wide bid at the top of the stretch and was ridden out. SOCIALLY CLEARED was unhurried early then finished well to gain the place. COOK'N LIGHT, well placed close to the pace, lacked a solid response. ROSES FROM DAVID failed to menace with a mild bid. LEONA'S DR. broke alertly, saved ground showing the way to the stretch then tired. LADY KREW lacked a rally. MARGE'S BID stalked the early pace and tired. QUITE AN ANGEL prompted the pace to the far turn and tired.
