ACES MARK circled rivals on the turn, took the lead leaving furlong grounds and slowly edged away. ELECTOR eased out on the turn, moved back inside for the stretch run, challenged in mid stretch but then lacked a further response. GERRITSEN set the pace well off the rail and then weakened. BLUE LIGHT SPECIAL raced wide and rallied too late. DRIVEN BY SAARLAND joined for command three wide and then gave way. CONTEMPORARY HERO failed to menace. MISTER FIPS (IRE) saved ground and tired. RICHER GEAR was between foes and never far back, tired. DIGITAL DREAMS broke slowly, trailed and was pulled in distress just before crossing the wire and was vanned off.
