BANJO PICKER stumbled leaving the gate, recovered quickly and set pace racing well off the rail, drifted out under left handed pressure to mid stretch, rider switched to right handed pressure and BANJO PICKER held on. Following a stewards inquiry, BANJO PICKER was disqualified and placed third. NITTANY EXPRESS rated outside, was carried out wider through the stretch, and finished full of run. WHO'S BLUFFING stalked two wide, was carried out a bit and steadied slightly in mid stretch and then hung. GRADED BY RESULTS raced well off the rail, also drifted out when roused left handed in mid stretch and was too late. BLIND CANYON failed to menace. VALLEYMAN showed nothing. THE HORSE WERE LATE ARRIVING TO THE STARTING GATE AND POST TIME WAS DELAYED.
