LADY ON THE GO was unhurried early then lodged her bid from the outside and drove to the front in time. SAINTTWOK moved closer on the far turn then finished willingly between rivals. INTERVIEWING, well placed close to the pace, lacked the needed closing response. SKIP TRIAL MISS prompted the pace, loomed boldly on the far turn then faded in the drive. AMERICAN FIRE broke alertly to set the pace into the final furlong and weakened. SUMMERTIME ALLI moved closer into the far turn then flattened out. DOTTED LINE prompted the pace and tired. NOAH'S ARK showed nothing. LADY DAISY was always outrun.
