ELVIS VALENTINO rallied five wide on the turn and took the lead, opened a long lead in mid stretch and held sway under mild handling. SCIBELLI rallied four wide on the turn but then had no late gain. HARDKNOCKINBILLIE raced wide and passed tiring foes. GRAND MOTION was very wide into stretch and was too late. JUST A GUY failed to menace. ZOARES LAND vied for command between foes and tired. JOEY'S PAL raced wide and tired. OFFICER RON showed little after a slow start. UNCLE ELI vied for command inside and tired. OUTCLASS dueled for command two wide and tired.
