ARRRRRR bobbled at the start then circled horses some five wide on the turn to gain the show. FUNNY BUCK raced close up near the inside rail then weakened in the drive. MONSOOR flattened out in the drive. TRAVINATOR bobbled at the start then showed early speed and tired. EXECUTIVE PRODUCER chased for a half mile then tired.
