DOUBLE COOKIE moved inside on the far turn to lodge a bid and finished second best. SAVANNAH'S CHOICE wide on the first turn, stalked the pace and challenged near the quarter pole and gave way. DISCO CAN DANCE flashed brief speed. CHATLINE vied for command outside, opened a clear advantage and then gave way. DAYS OF CLEO was bumped and stumbled at the start.
