JANEY GIRL raced three wide, challenged on turn, weakened. MISSY TURTLE broke to the right, was straightened away and moved to the rail, set the pace and then faded. FRANCE SOIR (CHI) raced just off early pace, tired. OUR PRECIOUSMOMENT was two wide and just off early pace, tired. LADY KATIE failed to menace.
