REXDALE WARRIOR moved to the lead leaving the turn then held off the challenge of R. BEE ESS late. R. BEE ESS moved up wide leaving the turn, loomed boldly through the stretch then hung late. ROMO TO T O was outrun early then closed well between rivals in the final furlong. RIDIN' HARD, never far back, lacked the needed response in the stretch. ALLON moved up wide leaving the turn then lacked the needed closing response. SIR WIGGLEY failed to be a threat. LAST MYSTERY showed early speed along the inside then faded in the drive. STORM PROOF broke sharp to dispute the pace to the stretch then tired. LEGAL TENDER tired. UPHILL PAPER ROUTE showed little.
