TIMBER CRUISE was just off the pace between foes, angled out entering the stretch, drifted out while clear under left handed pressure in deep stretch and got the decision. CHARGING HERO rallied six wide into stretch, moved inside winner when that one began drifting out, closed and just missed. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF CHARGING HERO AGAINST TIMBER CRUISE FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH WAS DISMISSED. BULLET RAIN joined for command four wide, took the lead and battled gamely to wire. PLOSH vied for command three wide and weakened. LAKEVILLE RUSH failed to menace. CATALINA FOG dueled just off the rail and tired. DONE THAT showed little. CARMELO STARBUCKLE was between foes vying for command, tired. NAKAYAMA ARASHI flashed brief speed.
