THE COLOR RED vied outside early, repulsed repeated challenges, edged clear in midstretch and lasted. GREAT BRIDGE outrun early outside, closed well in the final furlong too late. RELENTLESS BARBARA stalked the pacesetters for a half, bid on the final turn then weakened in the stretch. ONE TUFF BLUFF was reserved off the pace three wide, loomed boldly at the top of the lane then faded. SIMOOM raced inside and never menaced. RED BIER far back early, raced wide then was eased in the late stages. CATCHHERIFUCAN was far back throughout. LADY CASSANDRA vied inside to the final turn then stopped.
