**Footnotes**

WHAT A SMILE maintained good position three wide on the backstretch, raced at even terms through the turn, dueled with the disadvantage from the top of the stretch but dug in gamely past the sixteenth pole to get up the final yards. LALIQUÉ rated with the pace four wide while alternating for the lead on the backstretch, lost some ground entering the stretch but dueled with a slim advantage to the final yards before grudgingly ceding. INSURANCE MONEY rated off the pace toward the outside, saved some ground through the turn, eased out in midstretch and finished well. CHARMINGMEGAN rated with the pace inside while alternating for the lead, contested the rail through the turn then faded from the top of the stretch. MARYVILLE had a slim brief lead inside the opening quarter, contested the turn two deep, dropped back entering the stretch then weakened with a furlong to go. MISSBAUER was not a factor.
