BETTY'S HALO raced wide, challenged near mid stretch and fought gamely to the wire. RED HOT JAZZ prompted outside and then took the lead near mid stretch but weakened. THREETIMESAWONDER was well off the rail setting the early pace under a snug hold, tired. SHINING SEA raced wide. HOW BOUT TONIGHT showed little.
