ROYAL BRANDY raced off the pace, angled wide into the stretch, loomed boldly but was outfinished. MARKET RESEARCH raced inside when outrun early, angled wide into the stretch but too late. CUT TO THE CHASE vied for the lead outside, moved to the rail on the turn and came up empty in the stretch. DISH'S DIXIE was bumped about at the start and offered only a mild rally. TIPTOES IN DREAMS raced very wide, made a menacing move on the turn then flattened out. LAURA K set the pace briefly in the two path then gradually faltered. ALL NIGHT REBEL raced close up inside to the far turn then gave way readily.
