Footnotes

BANK OF DAD settled back toward the inside, was under a hand ride to close ground off the rail through the final turn, angled three wide in midstretch, dug in to gain the lead toward the sixteenth pole and drew clear approaching the wire. DISCO T rated a short lead off the rail, contested the final turn two deep, dug in with a slight advantage from the top of the stretch but was outfinished from the sixteenth pole. FIT FOR A FIGHT stalked the pace inside, contested for slim control toward the quarter pole, drifted a path in the upper stretch then weakened with a sixteenth to go. WAWASET PARK rated just off the pace outside, was urged close five wide on the final turn then weakened in the stretch. THE PRINCE stalked the early pace about the three path then weakened in the lane.
