MANDY'S GOLD pressed the early pace and made a three wide bid past the three eighths pole, then drew clear in the stretch while being ridden out. NASH'S PROSPECT was settled back early, then made a bid on the inside to get into contention, then angled out three wide in the stretch, but couldn't get to the winner while being second best. SEASONAL CHANGE was well placed early, then swung out three wide for the drive, but had no punch. JOHNNY TURK BAND was four wide into the stretch, but lacked a rally. OH WHAT A DOLL chased the early pace while six wide, then weakened. BERNIE'S GOLD failed to menace. ARIANNA'S PASSION set a pressured pace while on the inside, then faltered. GOLDEN LAKE stalked the early pace four wide, then tired. VIKKI SLEW chased the early pace five wide, then stopped.
