JOE'S SON JOEY was allowed to settle early on the inside, then angled out in mid stretch while be boxed in, then split rivals late to get up and prove best under a drive. TEXAS GLITTER dueled for the early lead and made a three wide bid on the far turn, but was caught late while under a strong hand ride. RUDIRUDY was well placed early on the inside, then angled off the rail in the stretch to make a bid, but was outfinished in a good effort. MIGHTY BEAU dueled for the early lead on the inside, then faded late. COURTLY RICHES was settled back early then was five wide on the far turn, then had a belated rally. GO RAIL GO dueled for the early lead four wide, then weakened. SPORT D'HIVER chased the early pace while three wide, then weakened. TEXAS CODE failed to menace. LOADED GUN was not a factor.
