CAPITALISM was badly outrun early, closed well outside. LETTER PERFECT raced three wide in top flight, weakened. VIENNA HILLS was boxed in near the quarter pole and wasn't a serious factor. CURLEW ROAD was two wide and just off the pace, had no kick. A. P. AWESOME raced wide and tired. TELLMESECRETS set the pace two wide and tired. SUNSHINE BO stopped suddenly.
