REE ENSIGN reluctant to load unseating her rider and delaying the start, raced far back early then closed strongly to get up in the final strides. EIGHT MADISON ROAD far behind early, rallied wide and narrowly missed. JELLYBERRY was outrun early three wide, rallied six wide into the stretch and was too late. LONESOME TOO made a menacing bid on the final turn, loomed boldly in the stretch but was outfinished. OVEROCKS forced the pace outside, held a clear lead in the stretch but was empty in the final furlong. TAPS RETURN far back to the stretch, rallied without threatening. TRUECAT within striking range early had no further response. PAULA'S APPROVAL raced outside and never menaced. JAYS HEIRESS was taken up at the far turn and had no further response. LIL'S NOVA set the pace to the stretch then came up empty. CINDY WOO WHO prompted the pace between foes then faded through the stretch. JESSICASBESTFRIEND forced the pace inside and began retreating on the final turn.
