### Footnotes

BULLISH SILVER settled off the pace toward the rail, checked at the heels of Mighty Mouser into the final turn, bid inside that one past the three eighths pole, came through a large opening entering the stretch and dug in gamely for the lead inside the sixteenth pole. SWEET BERNIE rated off the pace about the three path, bid between horses for the lead near the three eighths pole, contested off the rail on the final turn, lost some ground entering the stretch though dug in with the advantage to the sixteenth pole before yielding; grudgingly. CHAMP JOEY, unhurried inside, angled four wide making his bid into the final turn and finished well to show. FIREFIGHTER, a step slow to break, settled off the pace about the four path, moved to striking position into the final turn, raced at even terms from the five sixteenths pole but lost some ground entering the stretch and leveled off the remainder. GRECIAN PEGASUS showed no speed off the rail, made a mild five wide bid on the final turn then leveled off in the stretch. MIGHTY MOUSER rated a clear lead off the rail then gave way through the final turn. SUNSHINE SATURDAY rated close toward mid track on the backstretch, faded through the final turn then eased in the lane.
