**Footnotes**

SIX RINGS sprinted to a clear lead, increased margin in stretch then lasted while tiring in the final furlong. WILL BE THERE outrun early, split rivals on the turn and finished well too late. ALL DOLLED UP prompted the pace outside and continued gamely to the finish. REGAL LEXIE stumbled at the start, steadied near the far turn, was blocked on the turn then rallied. SMART GRACE close up outside, came up empty in the final furlong. STORMY DANYELLE within striking range early, raced very wide on the turn and flattened out. CROP ANGEL forced the pace inside and gradually retreated. CAJULENA close up early while four wide, had no further response. MISS WHIRLYBIRD raced extremely wide and was always outrun. BE MAGNIFICENT trailed throughout.
