LOST JUDGEMENT split foes on the backstretch, left was left with the rail on the far turn, shook loose in early stretch and drew off. HABBY'S STUFF was outrun to stretch, raced wide and rallied. ALISO CREEK duelled outside and faded in the stretch. EMILY'S JOY raced between foes while just off the pace and tired. DAWNS COMET failed to menace. THE GREEN WAVE was three wide and just off the early pace, tired. RAMBO MOUNTAIN failed to menace. ABOVE A LARK set pace inside, broke down on the far turn.
