CLASSIC MOON was hustled to a clear lead inside to set the pace, lost some ground through the turn but dug in to the challenge of the runner-up past the eighth pole to win the bob at the wire. SUNSHINE RONNIE chased the pace off the rail, eased out leaving the quarter pole and dueled gamely from midstretch though missed the bob at the wire. BRAHMS LULLABY chased the pace in mid track and was along to show. GAMEBOYE chased the early pace from the outside, came through the turn in mid track, was carried out at the quarter pole and weakened in the stretch. BEECHMONT chased the pace from the outside and had no response on the turn. JAKE'S LION and MY BOY STEVE were not factors. MATHEWLOVESTOPARTY chased the pace off the rail to the five sixteenths pole, took a bad step at that point, then eased and was vanned off.
