DR. FIELD rated close off the rail, bid three wide into the final turn to get the lead near the five sixteenths pole then dug in for a long determined drive and victory. JACKIE LAD rated a short lead inside, contested the final turn and continued in game fashion through the lane though ultimately placing. OFF THE GLASS rated just off the pace four wide, bid into the final turn, was carried out leaving the quarter pole but recovered stride inside the eighth pole and finished well. YO SAY, unhurried about the four path, bid into the final turn, angled out leaving the quarter pole taking Off The Glass with him then leveled off from the eighth pole. GO NOW showed no speed off the rail, bid mildly inside on the final turn but flattened stride through the lane. KELLERS CHURCH RD. gave chase toward the outside, came through the final turn widest then weakened. MIDATLANTIC rated with the pace two deep, contested the final turn then weakened at the quarter pole. HELLO JERRY lost contact after a half. KID LEMONADE broke down leaving the first turn.
